The process for evicting tenants from your propetry



## WHAT ARE POSSESSION **PROCEEDINGS?**

When a landlord wishes to take back possession of their property it may require the eviction of the tenant.

Possession proceedings is a process using Section 8 or Section 21 of the Housing Act 1988 which enables a landlord to regain possession of their property.

Section 8 is commonly used for circumstances where the tenant is in breach of their tenancy agreement.

Section 21, often referred to as a nofault eviction, is commonly used to evict a tenant where there has been no apparent breach of their tenancy agreement.

In both cases, a solicitor can guide the landlord through the process, advising on the most appropriate route to take.

Section 21 is presently under review and may cease to exist as part of the Renters Reform Bill.
